Dulce BUSTAMANTE from the Philippines



31 years old.

Atty. Dulce S. Bustamante-Delmo is the Executive Director of the Union of Legitimate Service Contracting Cooperatives in the Philippines, a cooperative union whose main advocacy is for the development, training, and support to labor service cooperatives.

She also serves as the Chairperson of the ICA-AP Committee on Youth Cooperation and the ex-officio Vice-President for Asia Pacific of the ICA Youth Committee. She is also a founding member of Young Entrepreneurs Service Cooperative, the first youth cooperative in their local region.



She is also the Managing Partner of a law firm based in the Philippines.

As a cooperator, she has taken on various roles as trainer and program implementor especially in the development of laboratory and youth cooperatives. Now in the labor and service sector, her advocacy is to promote cooperative laws and framework locally and internationally. Her expertise includes youth development, labor service, governance, and cooperatives.

Tinotenda Ronald Nyamukuwa is a 30-year-old business leader and passionate advocate for grassroots empowerment, with over five years of experience supporting youth and women entrepreneurs. He holds a Bachelor's degree in Information Systems and a Master of Technology in Strategy and Innovation. A multi-award winner, Tinotenda co-founded Zimbabwe's first ICT cooperative and played a key role in a national initiative to build a database connecting cooperatives across the country, in collaboration with ZINAHCO—an affiliate of the International Cooperative Alliance (ICA). He currently serves as Secretary of TechUnity, where he champions innovation for cooperatives.

I'm Harsh Mukeshbhai Sanghani, a passionate cooperator building 21st-century solutions through 100-year-old ancient values. From empowering farmers as Yuva Agriculture Minister of Gujarat to launching the *Youth in Cooperatives* movement, my journey has always been about unlocking the full potential of cooperative models—beyond tradition, into transformation.

I believe the future of cooperatives lies not just in agriculture and finance, but in AI, cybersecurity, climate tech, and digital infrastructure. That's why I've championed farmer-owned Carbon Credit Cooperatives and helped prototype cooperative



models in frontier sectors. My advocacy at the ECOSOC Youth Forum 2025 positioned cooperatives as the fastest route to achieving the SDGs.

If elected President of the ICA Youth Committee, I will work to launch the Global Digital Cooperative Incubator, the Youth Cooperative Leadership Academy, and a global Youth Cooperative Policy Forum—making youth not just participants, but pioneers.

2025 is the International Year of Cooperatives. Let's make it the year youth take the lead.

Together, we can build a world where every solution begins with "we."
